## 6 Installation and Upgrade Procedure

### Upgrading from 2.0.0

Due to a mistake in the release version number of Dolby Conferencing Console 2.0.0, please use the “yum downgrade” command to update Dolby Conferencing Console from 2.0.0 to 2.1.0

For EL6 upgrades from DCC 2.0.0 to 2.1.0:

```
yum downgrade dcc-2.1.0.2-1.e16.x86_64.rpm
```

For EL7 upgrades from Dolby Conferencing Console 2.0.0 to 2.1.0:

```
yum downgrade dcc-2.1.0.2-1.e17.x86_64.rpm
```

For Amazon Linux upgrades from Dolby Conferencing Console 2.0.0 to 2.1.0:

```
yum downgrade dcc-2.1.0.2-1.amzn.x86_64.rpm
```

When upgrading Dolby Conferencing Console from versions other than 2.0.0 to version 2.1.0, follow the instructions in the *Dolby Conferencing Console Operations and Management Guide v2.1.0*.
